ICT updates Data Privacy Rules to meet Regulatory Requirements

Norma Grijalva, the Chief Information Officer (CIO), and Carlos Lobato, the IT Compliance Officer, who also acts as NMSU's Chief Privacy Officer (CPO), along with support from Vandeen McKenzie, Financial Aid Director, and Abel Sanchez, Research IT Director, requested and received approval from University Administrative Council to update two data privacy rules. The rules are related to Federal Information Security Management Act (FISMA) and Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act (GLBA). FISMA is the government-mandated framework that protects government information, operations, and assets. GLBA is a federal law that controls the way institutions handles an individual's private information. These updates are necessary for NMSU to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements and to ensure the proper safeguard of the affected regulated data.
