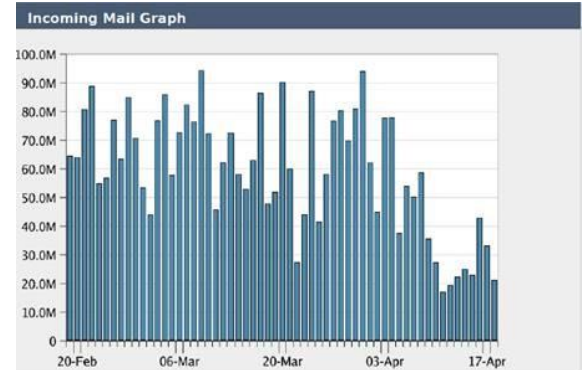


IronPort Email Filter Blocks Considerable Number of Spam Messages

IronPort, ICT's primary email filter works very hard behind the scenes to keep your inbox safe from the multitudes of annoying or malicious emails attempting to ruin your online messaging experience. Over 178 million messages were blocked last week between the dates April 8 and April 13. This seems like a large number until you compare it to the almost 3.5 billion messages blocked over the past two months. Only 14,406,489 clean messages or 0.41% were delivered. Without any form of email filtering, it's likely that email at NMSU would be completely unusable.
