Each year Facilities and Services Division provides the New Mexico State University Las Cruces community a detailed report on NMSU's water quality for the main campus. NMSU provides a very good quality drinking water that is safe and has not exceeded any contaminant levels established by the United States Environmental Protection Agency's "Safe Drinking Water Standards" during the past year. In order to ensure the quality of our water, the Facilities & Services Department routinely samples the water supply and tests for over 125 contaminants.
