Rentals

Purchases which require accepting terms and conditions or a signed agreement must be purchased via a **purchase order**. These purchases are **not allowed** on the PCard. Making the purchase on a PCard will bind NMSU the to the vendors terms and can result in legal consequences for the university.

Per BPM 4.00.05, only the Regents, the President, and Procurement Services buyers and their delegated representatives may sign a contract that legally binds NMSU. Per BPM 4.40.85, Purchases not properly authorized in advance...are the PERSONAL obligation of the person originating such a purchase.

Sam's Club

Sam's Club is now accepting Visa cards, so Procurement Services has made arrangements, effective immediately, for NMSU departments to make purchases using Procurement Cards (PCards) at the Las Cruces and Roswell Sam's Clubs. Membership cards for NMSU will be kept in each store's accounting office. These memberships are only for official, tax-exempt NMSU purchases.



To make an NMSU purchase at Sam's:

- Inform the information desk as you enter the store that you will be making an NMSU tax-exempt purchase.
- Gather items to be purchased. Remember that NMSU business rules about allowable and PCard restricted purchases apply at Sam's Club.
- At the checkout counter, notify the cashier that this is an NMSU purchase. The cashier will get the membership card from the club's accounting office to ring up the purchases.
- Payment must be made with an NMSU PCard; no cash or checks are permitted for these tax-exempt purchases.
- Retain the receipt for inclusion in the appropriate PCard reconciliation, following the normal PCard purchase procedures.

As a result of this change, NMSU will no longer support using purchase orders for Sam's Club purchases. In addition, NMSU will not reimburse departments for separate Sam's Club memberships.
